

ORDINANCE NO. 1536

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 551, BEING THE PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE FOR THE CITY OF BEAVERTON, BY PROVIDING NEW CHARGES FOR WATER CONNECTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the administration has recommended to the Council that the Public Utilities Code of the City of Beaverton be amended as hereinafter provided and upon due consideration the Council deems said amendments advisable; Now, therefore

THE CITY OF BEAVERTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Section 7(4) of Ordinance No. 551, as previously amended by Ordinance No. 1375 is hereby deleted and amended to read as follows:

"(4) Any person, firm, corporation or association desiring a permit to connect any building or structure to the Municipal Water System of the City of Beaverton is required to and shall apply to the City of Beaverton Building Department for said permit and shall pay a connection fee according to the following schedule:

(a) For all single-family residential connections the charge therefor shall be \$100.00 per connection, providing, however, that no more than one building shall be connected to any one connection

(b) For all multi-family residential and condominium complex connections the charge shall be \$100.00 for each and every unit in the complex.

(c) For all motel and other business connections, the minimum charge shall be \$60.00 for the first bathroom unit and \$15.00 for each bathroom unit over and above the first unit."


SECTION 2. The Council hereby finds and determines that it is necessary that the provisions of this ordinance go into effect forthwith for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Beaverton and the inhabitants thereof for the reason that it is necessary that adequate funds be available to provide the necessary water services for the inhabitants of the City in order to insure the orderly growth, development and cleanliness of Beaverton.

An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.


