AN ORDINANCE ADDING A NEW SECTION TO THE BEAVERTON CODE, BC 5.08.121, PUBLIC FIGHTING.

WHEREAS, BC 5.08.115A proscribes fighting, violent, tumultuous or threatening behavior which inconveniences or alarms the public or which recklessly creates a risk thereof; and

WHEREAS, there is currently no Code provision which proscribes fighting, violent, tumultuous or threatening behavior which does not affect the public; and

WHEREAS, the above described conduct is to be deterred whether the public is involved or not; now, therefore,

THE CITY OF BEAVERTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby added to the Beaverton Code a new section to be numbered BC 5.08.121, entitled Public Fighting, to read as follows:

"5.08.121 Public Fighting. No person shall knowingly engage in fighting or violent, or threatening behavior which is not a refereed or regulated contest, while in a public place or premises open to the public."


Section 2. BC 5.08.800C, Penalties, is amended to add the following:


"5.08.121 Public Fighting"
