AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BC 5.08.015,
APPLICATION OF STATE STATUTES, TO
CLARIFY WHICH PROVISIONS OF THE
OREGON CRIMINAL CODE OF 1971 ARE
INCORPORATED BY REFERENCE INTO THE
BEAVERTON CODE.

WHEREAS, concerns of procedural due process require a person charged with a crime in a municipal court to receive as fair a trial as a person charged with a crime in a State court; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Criminal Code of 1971 has provisions regarding criminal liability, parties to crime, justification and responsibility; and

WHEREAS, the provisions noted above may affect the rights, duties and responsibilities of a person charged with a crime in a State court; and

WHEREAS, BC 5.08.015 as currently worded does not clearly refer to the provisions of the Oregon Criminal Code of 1971 that are intended to be incorporated by reference into the Beaverton Code; now, therefore,

THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

BC 5.08.015, Application of State Statutes, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"5.08.015 Application of State Statutes. Provisions of the Oregon Criminal Code of 1971, as now constituted, relating to criminal liability, parties to crime,

justification, and responsibility apply to offenses defined and made punishable by BC 5.08.010 -.800."
