AN ORDINANCE RE-ENACTING BC
6.02.020(A), APPLICABILITY OF STATE
TRAFFIC LAWS, TO REINCORPORATE BY
REFERENCE THE PROVISIONS OF THE 1990
OREGON VEHICLE CODE INTO THE
BEAVERTON MUNICIPAL CODE AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Beaverton Uniform Traffic Ordinance incorporates by reference the State traffic laws contained in the Oregon Vehicle Code for the purpose of regulating traffic within the City; and

WHEREAS, the 1989 Legislature made changes to the State traffic laws contained in the Oregon Vehicle Code; and

WHEREAS, the Beaverton Uniform Traffic Ordinance of the Beaverton Code is now in need of updating to coincide with the changes to the Oregon Vehicle Code; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists because the effective date of this ordinance must coincide with the effective date of State laws for the purposes of consistency and effective enforcement; now therefore,

THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. BC 6.02.020, Applicability of State Traffic Laws, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"6.02.020 Applicability of State Traffic Laws.
"A. Violation of a provision of the Oregon Vehicle Code, as constituted on the effective date of this ordinance, is an offense against this City, punishable as provided by State law."

Section 2. Because it is necessary that this amendment take effect on October 9, 1989, for the consistent and effective enforcement of traffic regulations within the City, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect on October 9, 1989, following adoption by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
