ORDINANCE NO. 3756

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BEAVERTON CODE, BC 8.02.015, STATE CODES, AND BC 8.02.040, FEES, TO ADOPT THE 1990 ELECTRICAL CODE AND AUTHORIZE FEES FOR THE ELECTRICAL INSPECTION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City of Beaverton has adopted the Electrical Specialty Code for the State of Oregon pursuant to BC 8.02.015; and

WHEREAS, a new 1990 edition of this Code has been issued, and should be adopted specifically by the City; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon permits local jurisdictions to conduct electrical inspections and collect a fee therefore, and has established a fee schedule; and

WHEREAS, Council adopted an electrical plan review program pursuant to state authority and this program went into effect on September 1, 1990 utilizing the State fee schedule set by administrative rule; and

WHEREAS, the Beaverton Code should be clarified to specifically provide for establishment of the City fee schedule by resolution; now, therefore,

THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

ORDINANCE NO. 3756

Section 1. BC 8.02.015 D, State Codes, is hereby amended to substitute the 1990 edition of the Electrical Specialty Code of the State of Oregon for the reference to the 1987 edition of same.

Section 2. BC 8.02.040, Fees, is amended by adding the following language after the words "Plumbing Specialty Code": "and ORS 479.845 of the Electrical Safety Law"; and is further amended to add the word "electrical" after the word "plumbing" in the fifth line of the paragraph; and is further amended by adding the words "inspections and plan review for" before the word "structural" in the fourth line of the section.
