ORDINANCE NO. 3775

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BEAVERTON CODE, SECTION 9.05.035, TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF PROPERTIES WITHIN THE DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT TASK FORCE STUDY AREA WHICH ARE ELIGIBLE FOR EXCEPTIONS FROM CERTAIN PERMIT APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City passed Ordinance No. 3770 in April, 1991, which ordinance amended the permit application requirements for certain properties within the Drainage Improvement Task Force Study Area; and

WHEREAS, subsequent research has disclosed the existence of other properties which correspondence originating during the applicable time period identifies as being eligible for the permit exceptions; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to further amend the Beaverton Code's site development provisions to include these additional properties in the applicable sections; now, therefore,


THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

The Beaverton Code, Section 9.05.035F, is amended so that subsection 3 now reads as follows:


"3. The requirements of section 9.05.035F(2)(a) above do not apply to properties located from Canyon Road to Murray Boulevard to the extent that the application for development proposes to fill in the floodfringe. The remaining provisions of this Code remain in effect as to those properties."
