AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER FIVE OF THE
BEAVERTON CODE BY ADDING SECTION B.C.
5.08.602, FALSE SWEARING, AND AMENDING B.C.
5.08.800, PENALTIES.

WHEREAS, the State Criminal Code includes a provision that defines the crime of False Swearing; and

WHEREAS, under the State Criminal Code, a person who makes a false sworn statement, knowing it to be false, commits the crime of False Swearing; and

WHEREAS, under the State Criminal Code, the crime of False Swearing is punishable as a Class A misdemeanor; and

WHEREAS, consistency between the provisions of the State Criminal Code and the Beaverton City Code is generally appropriate; now, therefore,

THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. B.C. 5.08.602, False Swearing, is hereby added to the Beaverton Code to read as follows:

"5.08.602 False Swearing. No person shall make a false sworn statement, knowing the statement to be false."

Section 2. Subsection (A) of B.C. 5.08.800 is hereby amended by adding the following:

"5.08.602 False Swearing"


