# CODE

ORDINANCE NO. 3827

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER FIVE OF THE BEAVERTON CODE BY ADDING SECTION BC 5.02.017, PROVIDING PREMISES FOR THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL BY MINORS PROHIBITED.

WHEREAS, ORS 471.045 preempts all local ordinances inconsistent with the State Liquor Control Act, but allows all local ordinances consistent with the Act, to operate; and

WHEREAS, there is no inconsistency between the State Liquor Control Act and a city ordinance prohibiting the provision of premises for the consumption of alcohol by minors; now, therefore,

**THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

BC 5.02.017, Providing Premises for the Consumption of Alcohol by Minors Prohibited, is hereby added to the Beaverton Code to read as follows:

"BC 5.02.017, Providing Premises for the Consumption of Alcohol by Minors Prohibited. No person who owns or is in control of premises shall knowingly allow a minor to consume alcoholic liquor on the premises except as provided in BC 5.02.030."
