AN ORDINANCE ADDING A NEW CRIME TO THE BEAVERTON CODE, SECTION 5.08.621, POSSESSION OF FALSE LAW ENFORCEMENT IDENTIFICATION, AND AMENDING BC 5.08.800(A), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the 1993 Oregon Legislative Assembly created the crime of possession of false law enforcement identification which takes effect November 4, 1993; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Beaverton finds that possession of false law enforcement identification is conduct which it wishes to make criminal and punish pursuant to the Beaverton Code, 1982; and

WHEREAS, justice is best served when the criminal laws of the State of Oregon and the City of Beaverton are consistent and applicable on or about the same effective date; now, therefore,

THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. BC 5.08.621, Possession of False Law Enforcement identification, is hereby created and shall read as follows:

"5.08.621 Possession of False Law Enforcement Identification. No person shall possess an identification card that identifies the possessor of the card as a member of a law enforcement unit unless the card is lawfully issued to the possessor by a law enforcement unit."

Section 2. BC 5.08.800(A), Penalties, is hereby amended as follows:

"5.08.621 Possession of False Law Enforcement Identification"

Section 3. Emergency Clause. An emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect on November 4, 1993 after its reading, passage and signing by the Mayor in order to preserve the peace, health and safety of the City and to maintain consistency among state laws and city ordinances.
