ORDINANCE NO. 3870

**AN ORDINANCE RE-ENACTING BEAVERTON CODE 5.08.015,  
APPLICATION OF STATE STATUTES, TO COMPLY WITH THE  
STATE CRIMINAL CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, each State Legislative Assembly may enact, amend or repeal general provisions of the State Criminal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Protection chapter of the Beaverton Municipal Code often relies upon the same general provisions in prosecuting criminal offenses; now, therefore,

**THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** BC 5.08.015 is hereby re-enacted to read as follows:

"5.08.015 Application of State Statutes. Provisions of the Oregon Criminal Code of 1971, as now constituted, relating to criminal liability, parties to crime, justification and responsibility apply to offenses defined and made punishable by BC 5.08.010-.800."

**Section 2. Emergency Clause.** An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its reading, passage and signing by the Mayor in order to preserve the peace, health and safety of the City and to maintain consistency among State laws and City ordinances.
