**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER TWO OF THE BEAVERTON CODE BY AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF THE "HUMAN RIGHTS ADVISORY COMMISSION" SECTION OF THE CODE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Human Rights Advisory Commission was established in April, 1993 by Ordinance No. 3841; and

**WHEREAS**, the Human Rights Advisory Commission has now completed its bylaws and wishes to make certain sections of Ordinance 3841 more clear by clarifying the role of the Commission in investigating complaints and by deleting reference to the "secretary" to the commission; now therefore,

**THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The Beaverton Code is amended at BC 2.03.270, Organization, and shall now read as follows:

"2.03.270 **Organization.** The commission shall elect a chairperson and vice-chairperson who shall hold office at the pleasure of the commission. The City shall provide a staff liaison skilled in human resources and such staff as necessary to provide secretarial support and recordkeeping necessary for the commission. The commission shall meet at least four times each year and at such other times at it may provide by its bylaws."

**Section 2.** The Beaverton Code is amended at BC 2.03.275, General Powers and Duties, subsection D, and shall now read as follows:

"2.03.275D Make recommendations concerning solutions to specific problems of prejudice or discrimination in the city of Beaverton."

**Section 3.** The Beaverton Code is amended at BC 2.03.285, Information Required for Complaint, subsection A, and shall now read as follows:

"A. A complaint shall be filed with the staff liaison to the commission, or designee, and shall contain at least the following:
