AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER FIVE OF THE BEAVERTON CODE BY ADDING A NEW SECTION, BC 5.08.655, HINDERING MISDEMEANOR PROSECUTION, AND AMENDING BC 5.08.800(C), PENALTIES.

WHEREAS, rendering criminal assistance after the commission of a misdemeanor is a significant obstruction of justice;

WHEREAS, the city has authority to prohibit and punish conduct not prohibited under state law, so long as the local ordinance does not conflict with state legislation or legislative history; and

WHEREAS, the proposed ordinance is not in conflict with state criminal law or legislative history and is a valid exercise of the city's home rule authority; now therefore,

THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The "OBSTRUCTING GOVERNMENTAL ADMINISTRATION" section of Chapter Five of the Beaverton Code is hereby amended to add the following new provision:
 - "5.08.655 <u>Hindering Misdemeanor Prosecution</u>. No person shall intentionally hinder the apprehension, prosecution, conviction or punishment of a person who has committed a crime punishable as a misdemeanor, or intentionally assist a person who has committed a crime punishable as a misdemeanor in profiting or benefiting from the commission of the crime by:
 - A. Harboring or concealing such person; or
 - B. Warning such person of impending discovery or apprehension; or
 - C. Providing or aiding in providing such person with money, transportation, weapon, disguise or other means of avoiding discovery or apprehension; or
 - D. Preventing or obstructing by means of force, intimidation or deception, anyone from performing an act that might aid in the discovery or apprehension of such person; or
 - E. Aiding such person in securing or protecting the proceeds of the crime."
- Section 2. BC 5.08.800(C), <u>Penalties</u>, is hereby amended by adding the following new provision:

"5.08.655 <u>Hindering Misdemeanor Prosecution</u>"
