**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER FIVE
OF THE BEAVERTON CODE
BY ADDING A NEW SECTION, BC 5.08.140, INTERFERING WITH PUBLIC
TRANSPORTATION, AND AMENDING BC 5.08.800(A), PENALTIES.**

WHEREAS, interference with an operator of public transportation is extrahazardous given the circumstances of the operator, the vehicle and its passengers; and

WHEREAS, operators of public transportation are exposed to a greater risk of disputes by virtue of a high degree of public interaction; now therefore,

THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The "DISORDERLY CONDUCT AND RELATED OFFENSES" section of Chapter Five of the Beaverton Code is hereby amended to add the following new provision:

"5.08.140 Interfering with Public Transportation. No person shall intentionally harass, annoy or alarm the operator of any bus or train by subjecting the operator to offensive physical contact when the bus or train is operated by or under contract to a public body to provide public transportation. As used in this section, the term "public body" means the state; any city, county or special district; any political subdivision; and any municipal or public corporation."

Section 2. BC 5.08.800(A), Penalties, is hereby amended by adding the following new provision:

"5.08.140 Interfering with Public Transportation"
