AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER SIX OF THE BEAVERTON CODE BY ADDING A NEW SECTION, BC 6.02.750, VOLUNTEER PARKING ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO HELP ENFORCE PARKING REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, ORS 221.340 authorizes a person other than a peace officer to issue parking citations; and

WHEREAS, the city wishes to work in partnership with the community to enforce parking regulations; now therefore,

## THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The "TRAFFIC CITATIONS AND OWNER RESPONSIBILITY" section of Chapter Six of the Beaverton Code is amended to add the following new section which shall read as follows:

"6.02.750 Volunteer Parking Enforcement Officers. The Mayor may authorize a person to issue parking citations on behalf of the city if the person volunteers to enforce the city's ordinances and regulations relating to the parking of vehicles as a part of an organized program administered through the police department. Such a person shall be considered a volunteer parking enforcement officer and shall have full authority to help enforce the city's ordinances and regulations relating to parking."
