**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER NINE  
OF THE BEAVERTON CODE  
TO INCLUDE A NEW SECTION,  
LIFE SAFETY AND FIRE REGULATIONS,  
SECTIONS BC 9.07.010 - 9.07.020.**

**WHEREAS**, the city is concerned with the safety of inhabitants of multifamily dwellings; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed ordinances should help prevent or deter the commission of crimes in multifamily dwellings; now therefore,

**THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Chapter Nine of the Beaverton Code is hereby amended to add the following new section:

**"LIFE SAFETY AND FIRE REGULATIONS**

9.07.010 Required Peep Holes. Except as provided in section 3305(h) of the structural Specialty Code, the primary entry door of each dwelling unit of a multifamily dwelling shall be equipped with a peephole allowing an occupant to have a wide field of view of the area immediately outside the door without opening the door."
