**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER SIX  
OF THE BEAVERTON CODE  
BY AMENDING SECTION, BC 6.02.320, PROHIBITED PARKING.**

WHEREAS, B.C. 6.02.320 should be amended to clarify that vehicles are not to be parked on publicly-owned property for the principal purpose of either displaying the vehicle for sale or, unless necessitated by an emergency, repairing the vehicle; now therefore,

**THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Section 6.02.320, Prohibited Parking is hereby amended to read as follows:

"6.02.320 Prohibited Parking. No operator shall park and no owner shall allow a vehicle to be parked upon a street or publicly-owned premises for the principal purpose of:

- A. Displaying the vehicle for sale;
- B. Repairing or servicing the vehicle, except repairs necessitated by an emergency."
