**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING  
BEAVERTON CODE SECTION 5.02.030  
RELATING TO THE LAWFUL CONSUMPTION OF LIQUOR BY A MINOR**

**WHEREAS,** consumption of alcohol by a minor is lawful under certain limited circumstances, including when the consumption is of sacramental wine as part of a religious rite or service; and

**WHEREAS,** Beaverton Code section 5.02.017 is ambiguous about the circumstances in which a person who owns or is in control of premises may allow a minor to consume sacramental wine as part of a religious rite or service; now, therefore,

**THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

BC section 5.02.030 Lawful Consumption of Liquor by a Minor is hereby amended to read as follows:

"5.02.030 Lawful Consumption of Liquor by a Minor. This ordinance shall not prohibit:

A. Any person from accepting or consuming sacramental wine as part of a religious rite or service; or

B. Any minor from having personal possession of alcoholic liquor when a parent or guardian of the minor consents to the possession and the minor is in a private residence accompanied by the parent or guardian."
