

ORDINANCE NO. 3985

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER TWO OF THE
BEAVERTON CODE BY ADDING A NEW PROVISION
RELATING TO THE CITY PLANNING COMMISSION.

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission has requested that the Ordinance enabling the Commission be amended to provide for continuity in the membership of the Commission, its practices and precedents in cases of replacement of Commission members resulting from vacancies in and removal from office, now, therefore,

THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

The Beaverton Code is amended by adding a new provision to be numbered and to read as follows:

"2.03.093 Alternate Members. The Mayor, with approval of the Council, shall appoint one or more alternate members of the Commission. The alternate member having seniority as an alternate shall assume the position of a regular member immediately upon a vacancy in that position and for the remainder of the term of that position. Alternate members shall attend all meetings of the Commission, shall be entitled to all information regularly provided to members of the Commission and shall be subject to removal on the same terms and in the same manner as a regular Commission member."


