

ORDINANCE NO. 4113

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 6.10.015  
OF THE BEAVERTON CODE,  
SPECIFICALLY THE DEFINITION OF “TRUCK ROUTE,”  
TO CORRECT THE DEFINITION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the City’s Truck Route Ordinance, BC 6.10.010 - .045, prohibits persons from moving or driving a truck on any road in Beaverton except a truck route in accordance with the Truck Route Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, Beaverton’s Truck Route Ordinance is not a part of the City’s comprehensive land use planning program, rather, the Ordinance regulates the operation of the City’s designated Truck Routes; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance 4059 amended the definition of the truck routes subject to regulation under the Truck Route Ordinance, but erroneously described the Cornell Road and Jenkins Road truck routes subject to regulation; and

**WHEREAS**, the correct text is set out in an underline/strikeout format, for comparison purposes, as follows:

“Truck Route’ – means the following roadways and portions of roadways designated in the Comprehensive Plan within the City limits:

- US 26 – Sunset Highway
- Oregon Highway 217 – Beaverton-Tigard Highway
- Oregon Highway 8 – Tualatin-Valley Highway and Canyon Road
- Oregon Highway 10 – Farmington Road and Beaverton-Hillsdale Highway
- Scholls Ferry Road
- Murray Boulevard between Sunset Highway and Scholls Ferry Road
- Cornell Road south of Sunset Highway
- 158<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Merlo Road between 170<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Cornell Road
- 170<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Merlo Road and Oregon Highway 10
- Jenkins Road between Murray Boulevard and the east ~~west~~ City limits
- Western Avenue
- Allen Boulevard: Oregon Highway 217 to Scholls Ferry Road
- Hall Boulevard: Oregon Highway 217 east to City limits
- Oleson Road;” and

**WHEREAS**, the correction of the improper designations is necessary to properly enforce the City’s Truck Route Ordinance; now, therefore

**Section 1.** Beaverton Code Section 6.10.015 Definitions, at the definition of the term "Truck Route," is amended to read as follows:

"Truck Route" – means the following roadways and portions of roadways designated in the Comprehensive Plan within the City limits:

US 26 – Sunset Highway  
Oregon Highway 217 – Beaverton-Tigard Highway  
Oregon Highway 8 – Tualatin-Valley Highway and Canyon Road  
Oregon Highway 10 – Farmington Road and Beaverton-Hillsdale Highway  
Scholls Ferry Road  
Murray Boulevard between Sunset Highway and Scholls Ferry Road  
Cornell Road south of Sunset Highway  
158<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Merlo Road between 170<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Cornell Road  
170<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Merlo Road and Oregon Highway 10  
Jenkins Road between Murray Boulevard and the west City limits  
Western Avenue  
Allen Boulevard: Oregon Highway 217 to Scholls Ferry Road  
Hall Boulevard: Oregon Highway 217 east to City limits  
Oleson Road;"

**Section 2.** A correct definition of the City's regulated truck routes, being central to proper enforcement of truck traffic on the City's streets, an emergency is hereby declared, and this ordinance takes effect on its passage and signature by the Mayor.
