

ORDINANCE NO. 4151

**AN ORDINANCE ADDING
CERTAIN PROVISIONS TO CHAPTER FIVE
OF THE BEAVERTON CODE.**

WHEREAS, the City has the legal authority to define and punish criminal misconduct under its Charter and ordinances and to prosecute such offenses in its Municipal Court; and

WHEREAS, local governments are prohibited under Article XI, section 2, of the Oregon Constitution from enacting legislation that conflicts with state criminal laws; and

WHEREAS, the City endeavors to maintain consistency between its local criminal ordinances and state criminal laws; now therefore,

THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

The following provisions are hereby added to the Beaverton Code:

Section 1. BC 5.08.716, Possession of Less Than One Ounce of Marijuana within 1,000 feet of a School. ORS 475.999(2)(a)(b), "Penalty for manufacture or delivery of controlled substance within 1,000 feet of school," as now constituted, is hereby incorporated into this code.

Section 2. BC 5.08.717, Frequenting a Place Where Controlled Substances are Used. ORS 167.222, "Frequenting a Place Where Controlled Substances are Used," as now constituted, is hereby incorporated into this code.


