

ORDINANCE NO. 4507

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 6.02.030 AND 6.05.010 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE BY DELETING THE DEFINITIONS OF DISCARDED VEHICLE

WHEREAS, different sections of the Municipal Code are amended at different times and for varying purposes; and

WHEREAS, redundancies or conflicting code provisions are undesirable because they can cause confusion; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the Municipal Code be clear and consistent to the maximum extent possible; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BEAVERTON,

Section 1. The Beaverton Code is amended in Chapter 6, Section 6.02.030 Definitions and Section 6.05.010 Definitions, by deleting the following definition from each section;

Discarded Vehicle – A vehicle that is inoperable or not currently licensed. For purposes of this definition a vehicle includes, but is not limited to, the major parts of the vehicle, such as the body, the engine, the transmission or the rear end.


Section 2. This ordinance may be cited by the short title of “Deleting Chapter 6 Discarded Vehicle Definition.”
