

ORDINANCE NO. 4740

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BEAVERTON CODE CHAPTER 2.03
RELATING TO HUMAN RIGHTS ADVISORY COMMISSION AND
ADDING BEAVERTON CODE SECTIONS 2.03.550 TO 2.03.560
ESTABLISHING THE BICYCLE ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

Whereas, the Human Rights Advisory Commission would like to increase its membership to thirteen members; and

Whereas, City Council would like to add the Bicycle Advisory Committee as an advisory committee to City Council;

Now, therefore,

THE CITY OF BEAVERTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Beaverton Code Chapter BC 2.03.065 is amended to read as follows:

2.03.265 Membership.

The commission shall consist of thirteen members and up to two alternates, who shall be nonvoting members.

Section 2. Beaverton Code Chapter BC 2.03 is amended by including Beaverton Code Sections 2.03.550 to 2.03.560, which reads as follows:

2.03.550 Bicycle Advisory Committee Established.

There is hereby established a Bicycle Advisory Committee.

2.03.555 Membership.

The Bicycle Advisory Committee shall consist of nine members and up to two alternates, who shall be non-voting members. The Bicycle Advisory Committee may also include up to two *ex officio* non-voting members, one from a Washington County active transportation interest group and one from a Metro-area active transportation interest group.

2.03.560 General Powers and Duties.


The Bicycle Advisory Committee shall provide recommendations to City Council on bicycle and related active transportation uses in and around the City of Beaverton, and provide City staff with general recommendations on bicycle and related active transportation circulation, access, and general use.


